Application Deadline: Deadline for submitting a contestant application is **Thursday, March 8, 2018**. Submit an application to a TLFMC Secretary, TLFMCSecretary@gmail.com

Contestants are urged to be present at each of the following events at the times indicated to ensure that the weekend is a success for all.

Meet & Greet: A meet & greet will take place on **Friday, March 9th 8:00pm at The Raven**. This will give the contestants a chance to meet the other contestants, the Judges and the event coordinators. The contestants will also "draw" for their contestant numbers at the Meet and Greet. This number will determine the order in which they appear for their Interview and on stage Saturday at the contest. The contestants are requested to arrive by 7:30 pm.

Rehearsal: There will be a rehearsal on **Saturday, March 10th 2:00pm at Mad Myrna's**. The purpose of the rehearsal is so each contestant knows what he/she has to do and when he/she has to do it. Contestants are requested to be present at 2:00 pm. Followed by;

Interview: The Interview portion of the event will take place on **Saturday, March 10th 3:00pm at Mad Myrna's**.

Staged Contest: The staged contest portion of the event will take place on **Saturday, March 10th 9:00 PM at Mad Myrna's**. This is the first time that the audience will have a chance to see you as a contestant. Your first appearance will be in "Bar Wear". Your second appearance will be in "Fetish Wear". Your third appearance will be in "Full Title Attire". Only the winners for each title will make a fourth appearance on stage. **It is imperative that ALL contestants arrive no later than 7:30pm. If you arrive later than 7:30pm you will be cut from the contest, NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Victory Brunch: The victory brunch will take place on **Sunday, March 11th 1:00pm at TBA**. The victory brunch is encouraged to be attended by all of the contestants. This will be a celebration brunch for the winners.

If you cannot be at one of the scheduled events by the recommended time you must make arrangements with TLFMC President – Thomas Azzarella (907) 602-0569 at which time considerations will be taken and a decision will be made on whether you are able to compete in the contest. If you are late to one of the scheduled events without prior arrangements, considerations will be made on the circumstances and a decision will be made on whether you are able to compete in the contest. If you arrive later than 7:30pm on the evening of the Staged Contest you will be cut from the contest. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!

Requirements for Arctic Heat Weekend 2018

Contestants Eligibility Requirements:

All contestants must meet the following requirements upon entering as a contestant for any title awarded at the Arctic Heat Weekend Contest, March 10th, 2018 to take place at Mad Myrna's.

Each contestant must be 21 years of age and an Alaskan resident. By signature on the application, contestant agrees to allow photo, video, image and or likeness to be used in conjunction with participation with this event or other club publicity. This may include but is not limited to press releases print, web and other forms of media for promotional purposes.

It is understood that the purpose of receiving a title is to further a positive image of the GLBTQ community as a whole, the Last Frontier Men's Club, and the Bear, and Leather community.

Recipients awarded 2018 titles should be prepared, to the best of their ability, to represent their title during the full two year of his/her reign. They are not obligated, but are encouraged, to travel, speak, participate and assist in local club fundraising. If, Title Recipients chose to compete in National or International competitions the expenses are the responsibilities of the recipient except for the registration which the club will pay. The club will support any fundraising event(s) that the recipient plans to assist with those expenses. If the titleholders do elect to travel, speak, participate they do so of their own will.

In the event that a titleholder cannot fulfill the responsibilities of their title, their title will be forfeited for the remainder of the title year(s). The sash, if applicable, must be immediately returned to the president of the club. The club may also vote on the relinquishment of a title if it feels the titleholder is not performing his responsibilities or is portraying the Last Frontier Men's Club or the GLBTQ community negatively.

Titleholders agree to participate in the Arctic Heat Weekend 2020 to turn over their titles.

All contestants must be of at least 21 years of age. Only physical residents of the state of Alaska are eligible to run or fulfill titles awarded at Arctic Heat Weekend 2018.

Contestants agree to hold blameless: The production staff, The Last Frontier Men's Club and club Officers and Members, Mad Myrna's, The Raven, associated employees and volunteer personnel for injuries, economic loss, or any other liability.

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS

CONTESTANTS:

INTERVIEW

The "Interview" will consist of a question / answer period with the panel of judges. The Interview will last approximately 10 to 20 minutes on Saturday, March 10th at 3:00 pm.

INTERACTION SKILLS

Starting at the Meet & Greet and continuing through the end of the Contest on Saturday night, the contestants will be viewed by the judges for Interaction Skills. This means that the judges will be watching you in different social situations and taking mental notes on how you interact with the Judges, Other Contestants, and the General Public.

This portion of the judging process will play a part in the overall score received by the judges. In the event of a tie it will play an even greater roll, as in the event of a tie the judges will be asked to pick a number between one and one hundred based solely on this portion to determine the winner.

FOR ALL CONTESTANTS:

Each contestant agrees to participate in all of the categories of the Arctic Heat Weekend Contest required for the title that they are running for. These include, Bar Wear, Fetish Wear and Full Title Attire.

BAR WEAR

This will be the first time that the audience and judges will see the contestants. It will consist of viewing the contestants on stage in "bar wear" and the reading of a short bio on each contestant.

FETISH WEAR

This will be the second time that the audience and judges will see the contestants. It will consist of viewing the contestants on stage in whatever "fetish wear" means to them while a brief person ad is read for each contestant.

FULL TITLE ATTIRE

This is the last time that the audience and judges will see the contestants; it will consist of viewing the contestants on stage in whatever "Full Title Attire" means to them. In other words what you feel best represents the title you are running for. A "Pop Question" will be asked of each contestant at this time. The question is not intended to trip up the contestant, it will be something taken right off of the contestants application and is meant to be fun and lighthearted.

Judging

Judges scorecards will be collected and tallied at the end of each segment of the contest. The results will remain confidential until the winners are announced on stage at the end of the contest on Saturday night.

Judges should refrain from any discussion of their scores, preferences or non-preferences for any of the contestants with other judges or with anyone else during the course of the contest weekend. At no time before the winners are announced will any conversation take place between the judges and the contestants regarding any contestant's performance. Any such conversation may be deemed cause for disqualification of whichever party initiated or continued the discussion.

SCORING

The point values for each of the categories are listed below, with a maximum total from each of the judges. He or she may give one contestant a score of 77 and another 78, scores will not be rounded off in any way. Individual scores will remain confidential.

INTERVIEW = 200 Points possible

FETISH WEAR = 100 Point Possible

FULL TITLE ATTIRE = 100 Points Possible

INTERACTION SKILLS = 100 Points Possible
